## Synonymes (anglais)

pāñcajanyam — the conchshell named Pāñcajanya; hr̥ṣīka-īśaḥ — Hṛṣīkeśa (Kṛṣṇa, the Lord who directs the senses of the devotees); devadattam — the conchshell named Devadatta; dhanam-jayaḥ — Dhanañjaya (Arjuna, the winner of wealth); paunḍram — the conch named Paunḍra; dadhmau — blew; mahā-śaṅkham — the terrific conchshell; bhīma-karmā — one who performs herculean tasks; vr̥ṣṭa-udaraḥ — the voracious eater (Bhīma).
